

A support bracket is needed every few meters of cable tray



Overview

Traditionally, it has been recommended to install brackets approximately every 1 to 1.5 meters along the length of the cable tray. There are factors to consider when determining the appropriate bracket spacing for your installation. A cable support system consists of cable support lengths and system components, such as cable support fittings, support elements, mounting elements and system accessories. The cable support lengths and fittings can basically be designed as cable trays, cable ladders or mesh cable trays, in which. Cable tray support quantity can be calculated using a simple formula: $\text{Support Quantity} = \frac{\text{Total Length}}{\text{Support Spacing}} + 1$. $\frac{20}{2} + 1 = 11$ supports. In a typical project, a 20-meter cable tray with 2-meter spacing requires 11 supports. Cable tray supports are components used to fix and support. This publication is intended as a practical guide for the proper and safe* installation of cable ladder systems, cable tray systems, channel support systems and associated supports. 8 (Other Mechanical Stresses (A)) in that document provides requirements for cable support.
