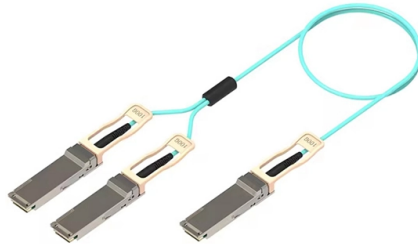


Characteristics of Drop Fiber Cables

Drop cables are engineered for flexibility and ease of installation, featuring a slim profile with 1-4 optical fibers (occasionally up to 12 for specialized needs). Their lightweight design facilitates seamless routing through tight spaces, making them ideal for both indoor and outdoor use. Fiber optic drop cables are the critical link between the main fiber optic network and individual buildings or residences. These cables bridge the gap between an ISP's backbone infrastructure and end-user premises, enabling high-speed internet, voice, and data services in residential areas. Fiber optic drop cables are mostly single-core or double-core structures, but can also be made into a four-core structure, a flat figure-8 structure, or a reinforcement structure located in the center of the two circles. Metal or non-metallic structures can be used, with the fiber located in the geometric center. FTTH drop cables are a last-mile fiber optic cable designed to connect the optical distribution network (ODN) to end users in Fiber to the Home (FTTH) systems. They lie at the end-user side and are necessary when FTTH (Fiber to the Home) systems are implemented. The cables, used alone or integrated into hardware, are common in harsh outdoor conditions.
