NEC (National Electrical Code) Article 300. 3 (C) (1): Prohibits the mixing of power and low-voltage cables (e., control, communication) in the same raceway or tray unless specific separation or shielding requirements are met. Cable trays are a support system for electrical cables, power, signal, and communication and optical fiber cables. It is available with a ventilated or solid bottom. Channel tray can protect against.
