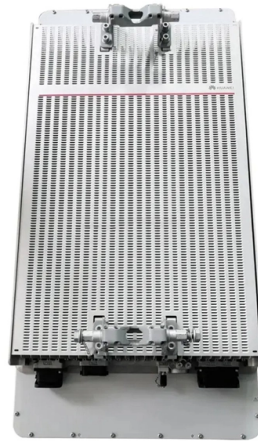


Fiber optic cable entering the monitoring cabinet



Overview

For fiber optic cable, use horizontal finger style with front cover cable managers in a 1U or 2U footprint. Consider wide body cabinets (wider than 24 inches) along with vertical cable managers (4", 6" or 12" wide) for core cabinets, main patch cabinets, or. For monitoring unauthorised entry, water levels or heat/fire in cable manholes, distribution cabinets or technical rooms Reasons for using a fibre-optic remote alarm system for infrastructures NEW!
