

Function of cable tray expansion joint support



Overview

According to NEC Section 300-7 (b), cable trays must be designed to accommodate the thermal expansion and contraction of the cables they support. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require.
