The grounding system provides a low-impedance path for fault current and limits the voltage rise on the normally non-current-carrying metallic components of the electrical distribution system. During fault conditions, low impedance results in high fault current flow, causing overcurrent protective. In the US, grounding and bonding are regulated by the National Electrical Code (NEC), while in the UK and Europe, they are guided by standards issued by the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) and national regulations such as BS 7671 (IET Wiring Regulations). SEC Distribution System extends from the MV (33 kV, 13.8 kV) feeder outlets of HV / MV Substations down to SEC Customer interface including KWH-Meters and meter boxes.
