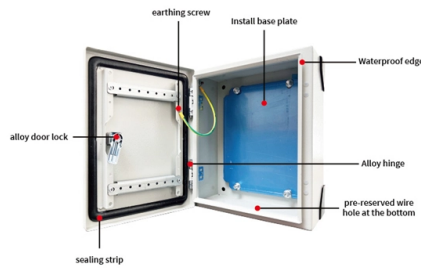


How much larger should cable trays be to use angle iron
