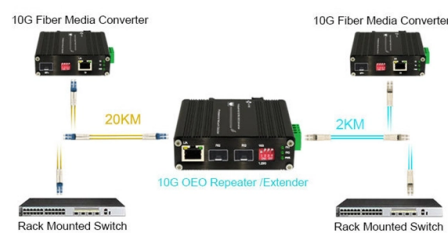


Is the international fiber optic cable provided by China Telecom or China Mobile



Overview

On June 7, China Mobile, China's largest telecom operator and the world's biggest purchaser of optical fiber, officially announced the shortlisted candidates for its centralized procurement of outdoor optical cable products for 2025-2026. Fibre-optic Link Around the Globe (FLAG) is a 28,000-kilometre-long (17,398 mi; 15,119 nmi) fibre optic mostly- submarine communications cable that connects the United Kingdom, Japan, India, and many places in between. The cable is operated by Global Cloud Xchange, a former subsidiary of RCOM. China Mobile International Limited (CMI) officially activated the PEACE submarine cable on 30 August 2024. A 15,000-kilometer link connecting Singapore and France, and further extending to Malaysia and other European countries, PEACE is designed to provide fast, open and flexible connectivity. Euro-Asia Network Solution (ENS) is a superior solution offering exceptional reliability and secure connectivity between all major POPs in Europe, China, Asia and Hong Kong. Based on state-of-the-art fibre optic network technology, ENS significantly enhances businesses' efficiency between Europe.
