A fiber optic cable or optical fiber cable is a medium used for transmitting optical signals from one place to another. This document aims to address the common questions and concerns received by Fiber Technicians as a result of the telecom industry prohibiting such a splice. Fusion splicing is the most widely used method of splicing as it provides for the lowest loss and least reflectance, as well as providing the strongest and most reliable joint between two fibers. When the fiber core is so small that only light ray at 0° incident angle can stably pass through the length of fiber without much loss, this kind of fiber is called single mode fiber (SMF).
