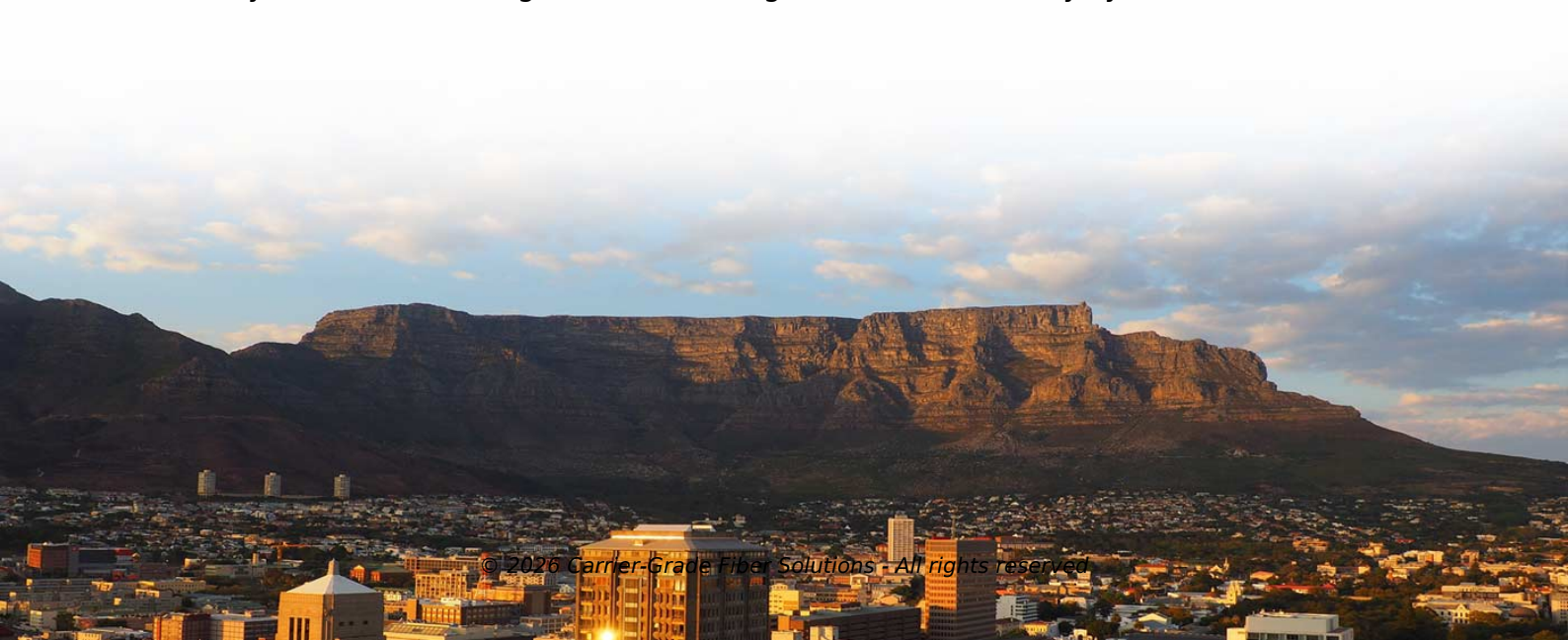


Requirements for outdoor cable tray wiring
