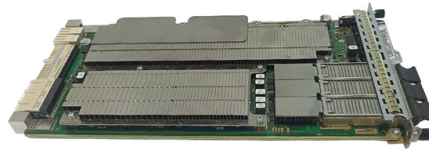


Spacing of Vertical Cable Tray Tie-up Stands
