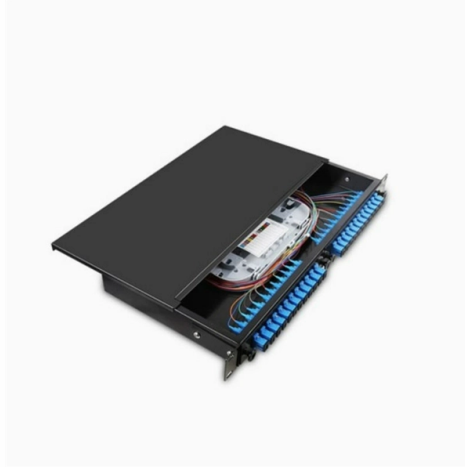


Touching the electrical box may cause an electric shock
